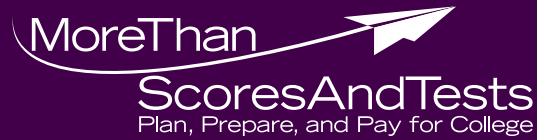



- College students are graduating with an average of \$27,600 in loans and \$3,700 in credit card debt.
- Scholarships make up only about 3% of college funding.
- At least 42% of FAFSA forms contain mistakes.
- The average college student changes majors 3-4 times during his or her undergraduate college career.
- One-third of students transfer in the first 24 months.
- An average college graduate spends 5.2 years in college.
- Fewer than 60% of college students graduate at all, and from those who graduate, only 40% graduate within 4 years.
